

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

Based on the results of this study, the writer would like to write down some conclusions and suggestions about honorific forms or systems in the Lewa language as follows:

5.1 Conclusion

1. In the use of the honorifics in Lewa language which is different from English, the use of the word father or mother in Lewa or Indonesian can be used specifically and generally, such as the Mr. pastor, Miss priest, but in English the greeting father is only used specifically.
2. The use of honorifics forms in the Lewa language is different from the use of English, such as the use of the words uncle and aunt in English in general. But the used of the Lewa language, the greeting of uncle (Tuya) is used for the brother of the mother, while the greeting of aunt (Mamu) is used for the sister of the father. Therefore, in the use of the Lewa language, there are several greetings that are not the same in the use of English.
3. The use of the honorific form of little father (Ama kudu) in the Lewa language, which is a greeting for the father's brother. while the greeting little mom (ina kudu) is a greeting for the mother's sister, this is a form of honorific addressing of kinship in the Lewa language.
4. There are several honorific systems in lewa, such as referent honorifics first person pronouns such as (Nyina) he or she in English. second

personal pronoun, you, your, yours, the same means in English, there is no difference.

5.2 Suggestion

After getting the result of the analysis, the writer would like to give some suggestion as follow:

1. For the students

Learning honorific words can increase the knowledge and benefits of developing a person's character which refers to the forms of use of honorifics and really helps them to be able to understand the honor system according to the meaning of the context of use in grammar.

2. For the lecture

This study could help to improve the lecture knowledge about honorifics especially Lewa language.

3. for the community

Learn honorific words can increase knowledge about the use of honorifics in the Lewa language so that they can understand and distinguish honorific forms and systems according to . context of use in grammar.

4. For further research

For researchers who are interested in researching more specific honorifics in regional languages, they can use this research as a reference.
