#### **5.1 Conclusion**

Based on the result, it can be concluded that in Wewewa language in Southwest Sumba Regency there are three types of homonyms. Such as; complete homonyms, partial homonyms, and grammatical homonyms. Complete homonyms found 31 words, partial homonyms found 4 words, and grammatical homonyms found 12 words. In this study, word homonyms, homonyms of word forms, and lexical homonyms were not found in Wewewa language. Language used in this study is Wewewa language which is often used in daily interactions of Wewewa people.
