Motivation is useful for fostering a sense of enthusiasm and curiosity from students about a learning process so that the teaching material presented is easy for students to understand.

According to Yusuf (2004) Kenniston in Santrock (2007) freshmen is a New student a status that is carried by someone in thefirst year of college. Students' age ranges from 18-25 years. They are classified as late adolescence to early adulthood or middle adulthood Entering the world of college brings big changes in one's life. mentions this period of youth, namely the transition period between teenagers and adults. At this age, also someone enters college as an important pathway to maturity (Papalia, Olds & Fieldman, 2008).

According to O'Malley & Chamot (1990) in Sartika et al (2019) language learning strategies are applied by language learners as a means to acquire and to use information acquired, stored or recalled by the learners, and can also promote autonomy learning. This happened because language learning strategy indirectly guides the students to become active learners that can provide their own needs and choose their preference in learning the language. Briefly, we can say that, the more students are able to apply strategies, the more they become successful learners, because they know their goal and find any ways to achieve it.
