CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

5.1 Conclusion

Based on the results and discussion above, it can be concluded that the teaching strategy for English teachers for class XI majoring in tourism, SMK Negeri 1 Kupang uses the strategy of teaching acceptance and discovery.

Teaching acceptance where the teacher plays an active role in presenting information to students, namely from general matters to more specific matters. After that, students are allowed to think about the application of the concepts learned.

Discovery teaching in which the teacher presents realities, cases, or problems to students. Then understand and solve it. Students find and express ideas, concepts, and ideas that can be brought into a broader study, especially in the field of tourism.

5.2 Suggestions
