CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

Based on the finding of the study, the research gave the conclusion:

The research of data analysis showed that collaborative strategic reading is able to help the students' personalize their learning in reading comprehension and it was also described that this material was an effective way when the students' are solving problem.

The data analysis test also showed that was a significant different between using collaborative reading and without using collaborative strategic reading. It was proved by development of mean score of the pre-test score of the experimental class was 47.30 the mean score of pre-test score of control class was 40.76. The mean score of post-test score of experimental class was 89.23 the mean score of post-test score of control class was 62.69.

The research results concluded that student learning outcomes in the experimental class were higher than student learning outcomes in the control class. Thus, it can be concluded that Collaborative Strategic is effective used to improve students' reading comprehension.

5.2 Suggestion

From the conclusion above, there some suggestion that are proposed by the writer.

1. For the English teacher are suggested to use CSR as an alternative strategy in teaching reading comprehension since it have been proven that

Collaborative Strategy Reading (CSR) technique can impact effectively in increasing students' reading comprehension.

2. The students are expected to improve their intensity in learning reading through Collaborative Strategy Reading (CSR).
3. The students need to realize that learning has two way process, not only teacher-center but also students-center. It means that they significant roles in achieving their success in study.
