CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background

Language has an important role in human life because it is used to communicate with one person and another. A language has its main components, namely; 1. Listening skills, 2. Speaking skills, 3. Reading skills, 4. Writing skills. The use of those skills create language which is very important in communication because it greatly influences the meaning of the message to be conveyed. There are two things needed to achieve for speaking skills, namely: competence of pronunciation and intonation. Learning speaking for that does pay attention to the two things mentioned above for sure will experience difficulty or failure. The obstacles faced by researchers in the process of learning English by students are as follows: lack of ability to pronounce correctly, lack of ability to use intonation correctly, based on texts in English.
