

## CHAPTER V

### CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

In this chapter consist of two points, those are conclusion and suggestion. After this research completed, the researcher gave some conclusion and suggestions for this research.

#### 5.1 Conclusion

1. Based on the research results obtained, it can be concluded that the application of mnemonic techniques in vocabulary learning can improve the learning outcomes of seven grade students at students at SMPN 5 Fatuleu satu atap. This can be seen from the increase in student learning outcomes in cycle I; there were 20 students (100%) who obtained a score of 70 or above with an average score percentage of 92.5 %

2. There was an increase in student learning outcomes after applying mnemonic techniques. Student learning outcomes experienced an increase, namely, in the pre-test, there were 9 students who achieved learning completeness (45%), and the post-test showed that students achieved learning completeness. There were 20 students (100%).

This shows that learning mnemonic techniques can improve students learning outcomes, as can be seen from the reality that occurs in the classroom during the teaching and learning process. By learning mnemonic techniques, teachers really help in the teaching and learning process in the classroom, and students can work together to solve problems. Students not only get the material taught but can also help weak students solve problems and develop abilities in their skills.
