## 1.1. Background

Phonology contains sound. It can never be completely divorced from phonetics, since sound patterns can never be completely and separate from how they are produced and heard. Phonetics is a part of phonology and provides for describing speech sounds. Moreover, McMahon (2002) stated that phonology is the language-specific selection and organization of sounds to signal meaning. It is really helpful for the English speakers, especially for non-active speaker. Helps the speaker to pronounce the words correctly.

Phonological processes are categorized as syllable structure processes, substitution processes, or assimilatory processes, whole segment process those are epenthesis or insertion, deletion, and metathesis. Syllable structure processes describe those sound changes that affect the structure of the syllable. Substitution or dissimilation processes describe those sound changes in which one sound class is replaced by another, According to Lass (1991). Moreover, English and Kupang Malay are two different languages with different phonological systems. For example, the word *stress* in English, in Bahasa Indonesian *stres*, and in Kupang Malay becoming *setres*, it is contains to insertion cause there is adding vowel /e/ between consonant /s/ dan /t/.
