#### CHAPTER I

It means that conjunction is a coordinator that is used to connect words, phrases, clauses, sentences or paragraph. One of the kinds of conjunction is coordinating conjunction.

The purpose of this opinion is that a conjunction is a particle or word that has an important role in a sentence. With the existence of conjunctions, the relationship between words, phrases, sentences, and paragraphs can become more coherent. Besides, it is easy for readers to understand. (Kridalaksana 2007: 102). According to conjunction is a category that functions to expand other units in hypothetical constructs, and always connects two or more other units in construction. Conjunctions connect parts of the utterance which are both equal and non-level. The conjunction function proposed by Kridalaksana previously is to expand the unit in the hypothetical construction. Hypotaxis is the combination of sentences with sentences, clauses with clauses, phrases with phrases, words for words, using conjunctions.

Ramlan (2008;40) state, conjunction is divided into two, there are (1) Coordinative conjunction and (2) subordinative conjunctions. The equal conjunction is a conjunction that connects the word, phrase, or equivalent or equaivalent clause (with it's level and it's position). Conjunction are not equivalent (subordinative) is a conjunction that connects the clause or sentence whose position is not equivalent or conjunction that connects the chil's sentence and the parent sentence. When viewed from its function it is distinguished by two types of conjunction, there are (1) conjunction that connects the word, clause, or sentence that is equivalent or equivalent and (2) conjunction that connects the clause with clauses whose position is not equal, but multilevel (Abdul Chaer, 2011:140-141). Conjunction that connects the word, clause, or sentence whose position is equivalent or equil means the conjunction that only connects the word, clause, or the same sentence position. Conjunction that connects clauses with clauses whose position is not equal, but multilevel means conjunction which only

connects the clause or sentence that is not equal or not the same level and position.

Halliday (1985:289) state conjunction are categories that function to expand other units in a hypothetical construction (combined phrases or combined clauses that outwardly use conjunction), and always connect two other units in a construction, conjunction also connect parts of speech that are equal or not. Conjunction are categories that function to expand other units in a hypothetical construction (combined phrases or combined clauses that outwardly use conjunction), and always connect two other units in a contruction, conjunctions also connect parts of speech that are equal or not.

The Gospel of Matthew is one of the books in the Bible, this research using the Gospel of Matthew as a means to get the senses that is conjunction. Meaninf of the conjunctions explain to the reader about the conjunctions that is an important element in sentences. If the placement of conjunction incrrocet, then the meaning of the sentences cannot be understood correctly, writer realize that there is difficulty in understandinh the form and meaning of the conjunction alone.
