

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter contains two parts. The first part is conclusion and the second part is suggestion. The first part contains the summary of the research which is related to the formulation and the objectives of the problem in this study. Then, the second part is suggestions which provide some suggestions for students and other researchers.

1.1 Conclusion

Based on the result and discussions of the research, it can be conclude that the types on conjunction of Gospel of Matthew and dominant types on conjunction of Gospel of Matthew . Three types on conjunction are identified coordinating conjunction 482 data, there are : *for 72, and 323, nor 3, but 32, or 16, yet 8, so 10*. Subordinating conjunction 448 data, there are : *After 22, as 35, because 31, before 31, when 167, where 19, if 50, since 1, so 12, then 35, though 5, until 13, while 16 data*. Coorelative conjunction 5 data, there are: *Either..Or 1, Neither.. nor 3 data*. The dominant types are classified coordinating conjunction (51,27 %), subordinating conjunction (48,28 %), then the coorelative conjunction (0, 44%).

The findings and discussion show that all kinds of conjunction are found of Gospel of Matthew in New Testament. There are coordinating conjunction, subordinating conjunction, and coorelative conjunction. The results of data analysis showed that the most word **AND** 323 data. On the other hand there is some data that is not found in conjunction.

1.2 Suggestions

From the whole activities of the research, the writer would like to give some suggestions for teachers, students and everybody who want to learn conjunction of Gospel of Matthew in New Testament.

1. For the teachers

The lectures have to introduce on conjunction of Gospel of Matthew on acts to the students by using this writing as source for teaching language and to get students' understanding in order to increase the comprehend about the types on conjunction of Gospel of Matthew and dominant types on conjunction of Gospel of Matthew, in this case the similarities and differences in any language.
