## **CHAPTER I**

#### INTRODUCTION

Rao (2019) stated that communication skills are essential in today's society,

There are still considerable problems with students' English speaking and listening abilities. Student proficiency in speaking and listening is typically low. They struggle to express their ideas and opinions vocally because they are self- conscious and fear making mistakes. They still struggle with some English word pronunciations. Speaking requires not only proper pronunciation but also a vast vocabulary (Laiya et al., 2022). Speaking is an essential English language skill to master since it demonstrates the ability to use the language to express one's thoughts to others in a communication. Podcasts allowed the students and teachers to share some information with others at any moment (Bahadorvar & Omidvar, 2014). Thus, using podcast not only give additional practice in listening skill but also can to increase students' speaking ability. The podcasting process is the act of recording audio, such as music, news, or speeches, and then uploading it as digital sound to a website or blog. Since podcasts offer extensive informal language. The learning environment in the podcast can attract students' attention and make them feel at ease while studying. In the previous study, Mohammadzadeh (2010) said that podcast serves a significant effect towards students' speaking ability and slightly endurance student's concentration and decrease the lack of attention. Supported by Putri (2019), Podcast media affirmatively shows good point for students in case it would bring the students closer to the target language, and it affects students' attitude and motivation.

More over, the podcast has been investigated by several studies. Mashhadi & Jalilifar (2016) mentioned that the podcast-mediated blended learning scenario appeared as the most successful scenario in vocabulary learning. Phillips (2017) found that the students had a positive learning outcome such as increase confidence of students who are reticent to speak English in the class, increased language confidence, fluency, and vocabulary acquisition. In addition Nwachokor et al. (2019) obtained that most students perceive that podcasts can increase productivity, promote creativity, and facilitate academic learning.
