5.1 Conclusions

Kafae event to the Maso Umanung and marriage advice ceremonies. In terms of

meaning is the meaning of a word that shows the social environment of its users,

the case of a double conceptual meaning if a word on the user automatically elicits
our response to understanding On the other hand, collocative meaning is meaning
that contains associations a word is obtained which is caused by the meaning of
other words tends to emerge in its environment, thematic meaning is the meaning

that communicated according to the way the speaker or writer organizes the message, in the meaning of focus and emphasis

5.2 Suggestion

he author suggests that the growing use of Tutu Kire among the Dulolong people requires special attention from the government. This can be done by establishing a traditional institution to preserve regional culture and supporting cultural figures in incorporating traditional wedding processions in all ceremonies. As these traditions are fading, this research aims to highlight their importance.

Additionally, the author recommends that the people of Dulolong understand the deeper meanings of Tutu Kire beyond mere celebration. The government should also preserve its cultural values to enhance community life by maintaining the processes that sustain it.
