CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

5.1.Conclusion

After analyzing the data regarding the types of associative meaning in Traditional Poems, the writer concludes that there are five types of associative meaning that used in traditional Poems namely, (1) connotative meaning,(2) Social Meaning, (3) Affective Meaning,(4) Reflected Meaning, and (5) Collocative Meaning. Based on the data analysis the writer found that,the function of associative meaning in this research. Function of Connocative meaning is used to communicate the experience in the real world. The Social meaning function of this meaning is used to deliver the social meaning which appears in language.
