

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTION

In this chapter the writer present some conclusions and suggestion dealing with results obtained through the data analysis

5.1 Conclusions

From the data that the writer analyzed according to the research problem mentioned in chapter 1, the conclusions can be arranged. The research problem are : what are the types of reduplication in Kotagana dialect of Nagekeo language? What are the meaning of reduplication in Kotagana dialect of Nagekeo Language?

Based on the results of research in the Kotagana Dialect of Nagekeo Language can provide the following things

1. Full/whole of reduplication contained in Kotagana Dialect Nagekeo language. In reduplication all the words that receive repetition are accompanied by with its meaning namely in the words *nua-nua* (express multiple meaning), *reu-reu* (a repetition process actually does not change the meaning of its basic form), *ye-ye* (a repetition process actually does not change the meaning of its basic form), *dəri-dəri* (states the action is basically done with pleasure, casualy or with pleasure), *rame-rame* (states that is manufacture in the basic form it is done by two parties regarding each other, in other words the repetitions state the meaning of mutual), *pesa-pesa* (express multiple meaning), *biṅuṅ-biṅuṅ* (a repetition process actually does not change

the meaning of its basic form), *wula-wula* (a repetition process actually does not change the meaning of its basic form), *feghi-feghi* (a repetition process actually does not change the meaning of its basic form), *dhara-dhara* (a repetition process actually does not change the meaning of its basic form), *la'a-la'a* (a repetition process actually does not change the meaning of its basic form), *wina-wina* (express multiple meaning), *siji-siji* (express multiple meaning), *bata-bata* (express multiple meaning)

2. Reduplication with phoneme changes with its meaning namely *midho-madho* (a repetition process actually does not change the meaning of its basic form).

5.2 Suggestion

Based on the findings and discussion above the writer present some suggestions as the application of research result for English students as the teacher candidate, readers, and the next researcher.

These are the suggestions:

1. For the English students and the next researcher, the writer suggest that they have learn about type and meaning of reduplication and they can do research using reduplication in other language or dialect.
2. For the readers, the writer suggest that they can improve their understanding about reduplication because it can be beneficial to understand what the writer means.

3. Young generation of Nagekeo Regency have to take care of local language as one the wealth of their culture that must be preserved.
4. The writer also expects that the results of this study well be usefulfor students who want to study about reduplications, especially in Nagekeo Language.
