CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

5.1 Conclusion

In this study the writer conducted this research to find out types of figurative language used in the song lyrics of "vessel" album from Twenty one pilots. The writer found that all types (twelve types) of figurative languages proposed by Perrine's theory (1969) as cited in Khairunissa & Iskandar (2022). They were allegory, metaphor, simile, apostrophe, synecdoche, hyperbole/overstatement, metonymy, symbol, irony, personification, understatement, and paradox. Based on the findings, it was found that metaphor and symbol are the most used type of figurative language and Simile is the least used of figurative language in the song lyrics in the album "Vessel" by Twenty One Pilots.

The songs on Vessel album by Twenty One Pilots deeply reflect mental health struggles, with songs about anxiety, depression, and the search for meaning. The album's title itself symbolizes the body as a temporary vessel for the soul, emphasizing that identity transcends pain or weakness. Songs like "Car Radio" and "Ode to Sleep" reveal pent-up grief, while "Migraine", "Holding on to you", and "Truce" share messages of resilience and hope. Overall, the album transforms suffering into art that gives voice to difficult feelings, offers comfort, and encourages perseverance.

5.2 Suggestions

1. For Students and Future Researchers

This research can serve as a reference and inspiration for students or researchers to continue the study by analyzing other albums from different bands and artists.

2. For English Teachers

This research can be applied in teaching semantics as authentic materials, making lessons more engaging and directly connected to learners' interests because the lyrics contain rich figurative expressions such as metaphors, personification, and symbolism.

3. For Music Listeners / General Public

This research helps to appreciate the song on a deeper level, recognizing not only the artistic use of figurative language but also the meaningful messages that provide reflection, comfort, and motivation in everyday life.
