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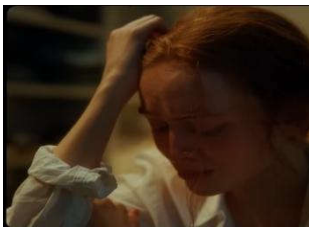

2	<i>“And I know it’s long gone and that magic’s not here no more, and I might be okay, but I’m not fine at all.”</i>	Affective Meaning	The lyric expresses the speaker’s sadness, emotional pain, and inability to recover from the breakup.
3	<i>“Sacred prayer, and we’d swear to remember it all too well.”</i>	Reflective Meaning	The words “sacred” and “swear” evoke ideas of commitment, loyalty, and broken promises.
4	<i>“They say all’s well that ends well, but I’m in a new hell every</i>	Affective Meaning	The lyric conveys intense emotional suffering and shows that painful memories continue after the realtionship
